

#### Blended mobility

- 3 schools participating (mobility)
- 3 schools participating virtually
- short term (1 week) or long term mobility (4weeks)
- preparing students for the future

#### Short term mobilities:

- travelling on Sunday and leaving on Saturday → full week at school
- pretasks (for everyone)
- tasks, preparation etc. during the week in the school

#### Website (French school will do this)

- open and closed space
- chat room for teachers
- useful links (schools etc.)
- open gallery for photos and videos
- blog

#### 1<sup>st</sup> meeting (Greece)

- pretasks:
  - school presentations (upload it to Google Drive and later to the website)
  - design a logo (send the logo by 6<sup>th</sup> November to Elli)
  - make a questionnaire (challenges of young people: studying, entrepreneurship etc.) for the interviews
    - students write 5-8 questions (question + answer options)
    - next week in each school → send them to Nina and she'll choose 10 for the questionnaire → will send them to Annalisa → will do an online questionnaire (survival monkey → makes the graphs etc. from the results) and send the link to all of us (ready by the 20<sup>th</sup> October)
  - interviews (filmed if wanted) done before the 8<sup>th</sup> November
- streaming conference (can be recorded and watched later)
- logo competition: Italy, Spain and France will vote between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> November and Greece, Poland and Finland will vote on the 12<sup>th</sup> (each school will vote for the best logos; gives the three best logos points 1, 2 or 3)
- start a blog
- interview videos will be shown and some of them will be uploaded on the website

#### Things to consider (host):

- questionnaire (allergies, diets etc.)
- program for the week
  - one free afternoon (for shopping etc.)

- certificate of attendance
- rules etc. for the students and hosts

    - the main ideas and benefits of voluntary work
    - workshops
    - meeting volunteers from other countries
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> week back in school again
    - trips, fair, normal lessons etc.
- Transnational project meeting (1 teacher/country)
  - o accompanying students in the beginning
  - o detailed plans for the mobility

### Italy (short term):

- Sun 6<sup>th</sup> – Sat 12<sup>th</sup> March 2016

Transnational meetings (autumn)

- 2 + 3 days
- 2 teachers/country

What happens after Greece before Poland?

- cultural preparations → making the students (and their parents) less scared of going to a foreign country
- video CVs (presenting themselves, what do they expect, what do they want to see...) November - December
- contact between host families and students

What happens between Poland and Italy?

- students look for information about entrepreneurs in their towns and prepare a presentation (how to become an entrepreneur? legislation)
- interview entrepreneurs in their towns (video)+ prepare a presentation of the results
- each country will do a document on how to set a business (rules, legislation, management etc.) → key points

In Italy:

- presentation of information
- comparing the results
- organize a workshop
- a blended lesson → working in groups for a business plan
- organize a visit to enterprises
