



# **ANALYSIS PART 1**

All teachers involved in the project were asked to fill in the same questionnaire. They were given 10 questions every May, after the completion of the project activities, in order to evaluate the impact of the project.

The questions and the findings are presented below. The order of the graphs is chronological,


### 1- Have you been involved at any stage in the project? How?

The option were the following

- · Participated in dissemination activities
- · Participated in group discussions and debates
- · Published materials on the school's web page
- · Worked on creating and publishing the project's blog
- · Worked on presentations preparation
- · Wrote essays and texts

As presented in the following graphs, during the first year most of the participant teachers (86%) participated in group discussions and debates, while half of them participated in dissemination activities, worked on presentations preparation and published materials on the school's web page. During the second year, the percentage of teachers who participated in group discussions and debates fell to 54% and the other responses were almost the same. Finally, during the third year the responses were similar to the second year with minor changes.

# TEACHERS RESULTS — QUESTIONNAIRES (EX-ANTE AND EX-POST) All teachers who participated in the project completed a questionnaire using the scale 1 to 5 right after the kidk off meeting in Finland. They also completed the same questionnaire in the end of the project so that we compare the initial expectations with the actual experience. The findings for each question are presented below (ex-ante in blue and ex-post in green). 1 - How much did the project make you interested in innovative teaching approaches? 
### **FAMILIES RESULTS**

All families involved in the project mobilities were asked to fill in the same questionnaire. They were given 11 questions after each mobility in order to evaluate the impact of the project.

The questions and the findings are presented below. The order of the graphs is chronological.
